Annual "Adopt-A-Healthy Duck" Rules & Regulations

1. A maximum of 3,000 ducks will be entered in the race.
2. Ducks will begin the race at Clifton Mill stream.
3. All ducks entered will be the property of the Greene Community Health Foundation.
4. Once ducks are placed into the stream, they are on their own. No attempt to free or interfere with any duck is permitted unless deemed necessary by the Race Marshall.
5. A number will be attached to each duck corresponding to the registration form. The first duck to cross the finish line will be awarded first place.
6. Winners will be announced 15 minutes after the first duck crosses the finish line. Race winners need not be present to win. Winners will be notified by mail, email or telephone.
7. No cash equivalent prizes will be provided in lieu of the designated prizes.
8. By entering, winners consent to the promotional use of their likeness without additional compensation.
9. By entering, entrants release the Greene County Combined Health District and the Greene Community Health Foundation, their members, agents, employees and other related entities from any and all liability with respect to prizes.
10. A list of race winners will be announced in the Greene County Combined Health District's annual report.
11. Chances of winning depend on the total number of qualified entries.

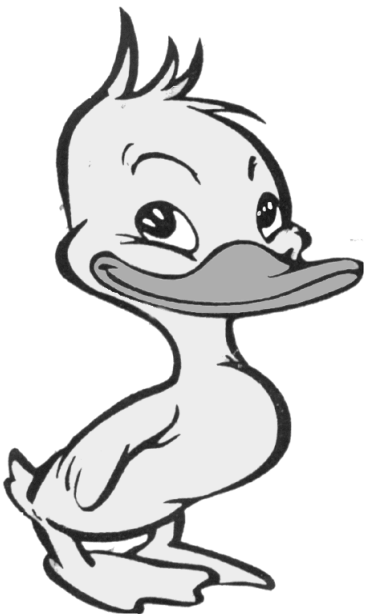
Certificate of Adoption
