OUR HISTORY

Under the direction of the late William P. McCullough, former Greene County Health Commissioner, and Board members Tom Seldon and Harry Johns, the Greene County Combined Health District (GCCHD) established The Greene Community Health Foundation in 1991. It was conceived as a way to address client needs that could not be covered by grant money or GCCHD funds. Since its inception, the Foundation has distributed more than \$580,000 in cash, and more than one million in gift-in-kind contributions. The Foundation is a non-profit organization that is dedicated caring for those in need.

PROGRAMS

Benevolent Care - Provides prescriptions, medical equipment and services, infant formulas and other personal assistance for clients in need.

Children's Books - Gently used or new books are provided for children who receives services in the clinic. Additionally, the waiting room area is supplied with books.

Children's School Supplies - A partnership with other agencies that provides school supplies for children in need.

Clinic Cupboard - The Clinic Cupboard is filled with basic over-the-counter medical supplies, baby items and personal products for Health District clients in need.

Infant Layettees - Layettes are provided by the Christ Child Society of Dayton and are given to expectant mothers when they complete their education classes.

Holiday Store - Assists clients by providing new items for children during the holiday season.

Mitten Tree - Provides hats, mittens, and gloves to those in need.

Partnerships in Safety - Local supporters provide car seats for infants and children.

Partnerships in Vision - Local optometrists and ophthalmologists donate their services to provide clients with eye exams and glasses.
