GCCHD and GMH to Provide Smoking Cessation Classes

XENIA, OH – Local residents looking for assistance quitting smoking are invited to register for **free** tobacco cessation classes to be held at Greene Memorial Hospital (GMH). The classes, which will be taught by a Mayo Clinic-Certified Tobacco Treatment Specialist from the Greene County Combined Health District (GCCHD), begin Tuesday, April 21st. The classes are open to the public.

Those who regularly attend the meetings will qualify for free nicotine replace therapy products including patches, gum or lozenges. Classes will include a step-by-step plan on how to quit and stay quit for life.

The classes begin Tuesday, April 21 and will run every Tuesday night from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. The location for the classes is the Medical Education Center at GMH, located in the basement of the Herman N. Menapace Center for Health Education, 1141 N. Monroe Drive, Xenia.
