Xenia, OH - As we eagerly prepare for the arrival of spring, the American Public Health Association (APHA) and GCCHD want to ensure that you and your loved ones are prepared for a possible public health emergency. With this in mind, the APHA has a campaign aimed at encouraging Americans to make sure their emergency preparedness kits are stocked when they change their clocks for daylight saving time. Daylight savings time begins this Sunday, March 8th.

The “Get Ready: Set Your Clocks, Check Your Stocks” campaign aims to build on the message of preparedness that already exists with using daylight saving time as a reminder to check the batteries in our smoke detectors, the supplies in your family emergency kit and to review your personal and family emergency plans.
