Greene County Combined Health District to Hold H1N1 Community Flu Clinics (nasal mist only) for Healthy Students and Eligible Community Members

(XENIA, OH) The Greene County Combined Health District (GCCHD) has announced that it will hold the following H1N1 community flu clinics (nasal mist only) for healthy students and eligible community members:

- **Monday, Nov. 23, 2009: Cedar Cliff Local Schools (gym), 248 N. Main St., Cedarville; 2:00 – 3:00 p.m. for healthy students only and 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. for eligible community members.**
- **Tuesday, Dec. 1, 2009: Yellow Springs High School (gym), 420 E. Enon Rd., Yellow Springs; 2:00 – 3:15 p.m. for healthy students only and 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. for eligible community members.**
- **Thursday, Dec. 3, 2009: Fairborn High School (auditorium), 900 East Dayton-Yellow Springs Rd., Fairborn; 12:00 – 2:00 p.m. for healthy students only and 3:00 – 7:00 p.m. for eligible community members.**
- **Tuesday, Dec. 8, 2009: Greeneview High School (music room), 4710 Cottonville Rd., Jamestown; 2:00 – 3:00 p.m. for healthy students only and 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. for eligible community members.**
- **Thursday, Dec. 10, 2009: Sugarcreek Educational Center (gym), 3757 Upper Bellbrook Rd., Bellbrook; 12:30 – 2:00 p.m. for healthy students only and 4:15 – 7:00 p.m. for eligible community members.**

Flumist is the only vaccine available at these clinics, so **ONLY** the following healthy people are eligible for vaccination at these clinics:

- **Healthy children and young adults ages 2 years to 24 years of age**
- **Healthy persons 49 years or younger who live with or provide care for infants less than 6 months of age**
- **Healthy persons 49 years or younger who are health-care or emergency medical personnel.**

Pregnant women are NOT eligible for these nasal mist clinics. There is no charge for the H1N1 vaccine.

Additional H1N1 flu clinics will be scheduled as more H1N1 vaccine becomes available.
