## Greene County Combined Health District to Hold Flu Clinics for General Public (6 months of age and older)

### REMINDER: Children under 10 years of age need two (2) doses of H1N1

(XENIA, OH) The Greene County Combined Health District (GCCHD) will hold several flu clinics throughout the county in the coming weeks. Both H1N1 and seasonal flu vaccine will be available at most sites. These clinics are open to anyone 6 months of age and older.

**For H1N1**, both injections and the nasal mist will be available. There is no charge for the H1N1 vaccine.

**For seasonal flu**, the cost is \$25.00 for adults and \$15.00 for children. We accept Medicaid, CareSource, Molina, AmeriGroup or Medicare Part B. People with Medicare Part C and other insurances will need to pay cash and send a receipt to their insurance company for reimbursement. Cash and checks will be accepted.

The clinic schedule is as follows:

- **Thursday, Feb. 4, 2010: by appointment only; at the Health District offices, 360 Wilson Dr., Xenia.** Both H1N1 and seasonal flu vaccine will be available.
- **Thursday, February 4, 2010 from 4 pm – 6 pm at the Sugarcreek Educational Center, 3757 Upper Bellbrook Rd., Bellbrook.** No appointment is needed. Both H1N1 and seasonal flu vaccine will be available.
- **Saturday, February 6, 2010 from 1 pm – 5 pm at the Mall at Fairfield Commons, 2727 Fairfield Commons, Beavercreek (across from the food court next to Yankee Candle).** No appointment is needed. Only H1N1 flu vaccine will be available at the Mall at Fairfield Commons. For easiest access, enter at upper level next to Dick's Sporting Goods or JC Penney.
- **Monday, February 8, 2010, from 2 pm – 7 pm at the Greene, 60 Plum St., Beavercreek (in the old S & K Men's store, between Payless and NY & Co., just down from Potbelly).** No appointment is needed. Both H1N1 and seasonal flu vaccine will be available.
- **Thursday, Feb. 11, 2010: by appointment only; at the Health District offices, 360 Wilson Dr., Xenia.** Both H1N1 and seasonal flu vaccine will be available.

The GCCHD reminds parents and health care providers that **children younger than 10 years of age should receive two doses of H1N1 flu vaccine** in order to achieve optimal protection against pandemic flu. The two doses of H1N1 vaccine need to be at least 28 days apart to be effective.
